SUBJECTWISE AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

ENGLISH/HINDI (ORAL AND WRITTEN)

1. Read, recite and write alphabets in the correct sequence and correct formation
2. Recognize and name alphabets.
3. Introduction of pre writing skills.
4. Write dictated alphabets.
5. Do exercises like circle the correct letter, match the alphabet etc.

MATH (ORAL AND WRITTEN)

1. Recognize, read, recite and write numbers in order.
2. Recognize and name numbers.
3. Understand what each numeral stands for.
4. Write dictated numbers
5. Do exercises like count and circle, count and write, write the missing numbers etc.
6. Recognize and name basic shapes.

RECITATION

1. Appreciate and enjoy rhymes and short poems.
2. Develop concepts of rhyme and rhythm through poems.
3. Develop memorizations skills and recitation skills.

E.V.S

1. Learn about themselves and the world in which they live.
2. Observe nature and appreciate the world God created.
3. Comprehend and answer questions related to the concepts on each topic.
4. Involve in activities to reinforce and stimulate learning of the concepts.
(Students will be given worksheets which will guide parents)

CONVERSATION & LISTENING SKILLS.

1. Development of oral communication skills (to speak clearly and correctly) and share experiences and ideas.
2. Development of comprehension skills and vocabulary through picture reading and short stories.
3. Development of ability to answer simple questions in short sentences.
4. Introduction of concepts of big and small, in and out, up and down, wet and dry, day and night, happy and sad.
5. Develop Listening skills through stories being read aloud and recalling them and also through classroom instructions etc.

MORAL EDUCATION

1. Character building through Bible stories.
2. Recall stories, answer simple questions and memory verses.
(Students will be given story sheets which will guide parents)

ART AND CRAFT

1. Learn to draw using simple geometric shapes.
2. Use crayons to colour pictures keeping within the lines.
3. Identify basic colours.
4. Develop simple skills of paper tearing and pasting.
