PRE - NURSERY CLASS 2025 -2026 SUBJECTWISE AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

ENGLISH/HINDI (ORAL AND WRITTEN)

- 1. Read, recite and write alphabets in the correct sequence and correct formation
- 2. Recognize and name alphabets.
- 3. Introduction of pre writing skills.
- 4. Write dictated alphabets.
- 5. Do exercises like circle the correct letter, match the alphabet etc.

MATH (ORAL AND WRITTEN)

- 1. Recognize, read, recite and write numbers in order.
- 2. Recognize and name numbers.
- 3. Understand what each numeral stands for.
- 4. Write dictated numbers
- 5. Do exercises like count and circle, count and write, write the missing numbers etc.
- 6. Recognize and name basic shapes.

RECITATION

- 1. Appreciate and enjoy rhymes and short poems.
